Dear Neighbor,

I intend to apply for a Short-Term Rental License to rent my home under the program established by Prince George's County through CB-11-2018. The program begins October 1, 2019. The Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (DPIE) has been designated to manage the program.

The legislation requires me to notify the neighbors whose properties abut mine.

Approval of my application is contingent upon me attesting to having fulfilled the regulations set forth in the law, as well as requirements from platforms that will participate in the program, such as Airbnb. Platforms are the agencies that advertise eligible rental properties.

Approval of my application is in no way a declaration from Prince George's County that I have fulfilled each requirement, but that I have declared to have done so. Failure to obey the law and maintain the conditions set forth by the platform may result in suspension or revocation of my Short-Term Rentals License.
