

 - Character, Integrity, Reputation
 - Previous Performance
 - Bid Price is Sufficient to Assure the Performance of the Bidder

Bids and Proposals

- Responsiveness
 - Conforms in all material respects to the Invitation for Bids
 - Minor Irregularities
 - Multiple Irregularities
