CHARGES:

Prince George's County Animal Services Division is requesting a Dangerous Dog Hearing for Lachone Brown's male, 3-year-old American Pit Bull Terrier named 'King'. On May 19, 2022, Police Communications requested an Animal Control Officer to respond to the above address for a dog bite. Police reported that the owner and her daughter flagged down Police in the area to report they were both bitten by their own dog "King" a brindle pit bull mix. According to police, both adults have been heavily drinking and there is a toddler in the home. Corporal Ronald Owens of the police department was concerned about leaving the dog in the apartment and requested an ACO respond. Officer Deppner #905 responded to the address and impounded the biting dog. This is in violation of Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animal', Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Owner', Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animal', and Section 3-186 'Vaccination of Ferrets, Dogs, and Cats' of the Prince George's County Code.

PETITION:

For return of custody of Lachone Brown's dog, a male, 3-year-old American Pit Bull Terrier named 'King' and appeal of the charges brought against them by Prince George's County Animal Services.

CHARGES:

Prince George’s County Animal Services Division is requesting a Dangerous Dog Hearing for David Carregosa and Natalie Umana’s male, 2-year-old American Pit Bull Terrier named ‘Ace’. On May 23, 2022, Prince Georges County Police communications requested an Animal Control Officer be dispatched to the above location for a dog bite. Upon arrival Officer Fowble #909 spoke with all parties and confirmed that while being walked on leash the dog above bit the victim, Mr. Debbagh, in the thigh while walking past the dog above. This is in violation of Section 3-131 ‘Manner of Keeping Animals; Prohibition of Nuisances’, Section 3-136 ‘Dangerous Animal’, Section 3-182 ‘Potentially Dangerous Animal’, and Section 3-186 ‘Vaccination of Ferrets, Dogs, and Cats’ of the Prince George’s County Code.

For return of custody of David Carregosa and Natalie Umana’s dog, a male, 2-year-old American Pit Bull Terrier named ‘Ace’ and appeal of the charges brought against them by Prince George’s County Animal Services.

CHARGES:

Prince George’s County Animal Services Division is requesting a Dangerous Dog Hearing for Jessica Alvarez’s male, 2-year-old American Pit Bull Terrier named ‘Apex’. On May 10, 2022, citizen called in to report an adult size Pitbull just killed a brown colored medium size stray dog in front of her house at 7309 Powhatan St. Lanham MD. Officer Deppner responded that evening and located the deceased dog but was unable to locate the attacking dog at that time. On May 11, 2022, the same citizen called back to state the Pitbull that killed a dog in front of her home the day before was back at her address smelling the area where the dog was killed. Officer Adams #914 responded and was able to follow the dog home to 7223 Kidmore Ln and met with a Jorge Flores who claimed to be the owner and where the dog was impounded from due to breed and fatal attack the day before. This is in violation of Section 3-131 ‘Manner of Keeping Animals; Prohibition of Nuisances’, Section 3-135 ‘Animals at Large Prohibited’, Section 3-136 ‘Dangerous Animal’, Section 3-142 ‘Irresponsible Owner’, Section 3-182 ‘Potentially Dangerous Animal’, and Section 3-186 ‘Vaccination of Ferrets, Dogs, and Cats’ of the Prince George’s County Code.

PETITION:

For return of custody of Jessica Alvarez's dog, a male, 2-year-old American Pit Bull Terrier named 'Apex' and appeal of the charges brought against them by Prince George's County Animal Services.

GENERAL RULES

Cases shall be called in the order in which they appear on the docket. The Commission may consider cases out of the order presented on the written docket, at the discretion of the Chairperson, to promote efficiency and as an accommodation to the parties involved.

All attempts will be made to allot time fairly to opposing parties and witnesses. However, all persons testifying under oath shall speak only after receiving recognition and consent of the Chairperson.

Hearings are open to the public. Verbal and physical disruptions from the public are prohibited. Members of the public are required to comply with rules, directives, and orders of the Commission.
