

GREEN YOUR HALLOWEEN

Go green this Halloween and compost your pumpkin. The Prince George's County Department of the Environment (DoE) will collect pumpkins, in addition to other organic Halloween decorations including dried corn, hay and straw, for composting on **Wednesday, November 4** and **Wednesday, November 11, 2015***.

To participate:

1. Place items curbside for pick up (items are not required to be bagged, but paper lawn/leaf bags must be used if residents choose to bag materials for collection), or
2. Drop off materials at the County's Convenience Centers located at 3501 Brown Station Road in Upper Marlboro from 7 AM to 6 PM, and 12701 Missouri Avenue in Brandywine from 6:30 AM to 3 PM.

Pumpkins should be free of inorganic materials such as candles, wax, artificial lighting and loose decorations.
