- Responsibilities** Review and approve plans for the construction, modification, remodeling, and addition of all facilities licensed by the Health Department.
- Offer office and field consultations regarding plan proposals, construction, and equipment installations.
- All reviews for new construction/interior remodels/equipment evaluations, swimming pools, spas and splash pads will be reviewed through the online plan submission. Please go to the [ePermits Online Application Portal](#) and enter the information directly into the County's Permitting System.
- Food Service Facilities: Review plans for new construction/interior remodels**
- Restaurants
 - Carry outs
 - Grocery stores
 - Catering facilities
 - Theater/stadium/amusement park concessions

 - Nursing homes

Food Service Facilities: Review plans for new construction/interior remodels
(continued)

- Hospitals (kitchen and food pantry)
- Assisted living facilities (kitchen only with more than 16 beds)
- Miscellaneous institutional centers (commercial kitchen)
- Public and private schools (cafeteria and culinary kitchens where food is being prepared onsite)
- Penal institutions for adult and children (kitchen areas only)

Wells and Septic Systems

- Review and inspect new residential construction for an onsite sewage disposal system and issue the permit
- Review and inspect residential installation for new drinking wells and issue the permit

Raze Permit

- Respond to raze requests to ensure asbestos abatement prior to demolition
- Inspect the structure for visible suspect friable asbestos-containing material (ACM); asbestos-containing material is material containing more than one percent asbestos
- Inspect the property for an abandoned well or septic system

Pools/Spas

Review and approve plans or remodels for all public swimming pools, spas, therapy pools, splash pads, amusement parks [Six Flags], apartment complexes, fitness centers, HOA's, schools, colleges, Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission facilities, nursing homes, motels and hotels.
