3 Things You Should Know About: Childcare in Maryland for Essential Personnel

MD Governor designates no cost childcare for Essential Personnel.

On March 25, 2020, Maryland Governor, Larry Hogan, announced through an <u>Executive Order</u>, that all child care providers close except those identified by the State to provide services to Essential Personnel.

Essential Personnel are defined as...

- 1. Providers of health, long-term, or acute inpatient care, emergency medical, or phannacy services;
- 2. Public health employees;
- 3. Law enforcement personnel;
- 4. Correctional services employees;
- 5. Firefighters and other first responders;
- 6. Government employees required to work during the state of emergency or catastrophic health emergency;
- 7. Employees and representatives of insurance carrieers, and those authorized by the MD Insurance Agency to engage in the business of insurance;
- 8. National Guard personnel called to active duty;
- 9. Staff and providers of child care or education services, including custodal staff and food service providers;
- 10. Food distributors and suppliers, including industry personnel;
- 11. Transportation and delivery services personnel;

- 12. Gasoline service station operators and auto repair mechanics;
- Critical infrastructure employees, including emergency support personnel for gas and electric utility operations, public works, water treatment, and waste management;
- 14. Personnel of other institutions ordered to remain open during the delcared state of emergency and catastrophic health emergency; and
- 15. Such other persons as the State Superintendent of Schools may designate in one or more orders as Essential Persons.

Parents and caregivers can request emergency childcare services now.

To obtain emergency childcare for a child of Essential Personnel, please:

- <u>Check this list</u> to see if there is childcare near your home or work
- If you don't see a childcare provider that meets your needs, call 877-261-0060 and a trained childcare referral specialist will assist you.
- You may be required to download and complete the following forms:
 - Family Enrollment Application (PDF)
 - Health History Form (PDF)
 - Medication Administration Authorization Form (PDF)
 - Emergency Form (English | Spanish)
