

## Existing Bridge

- 54' Overall Length, 36'-4" wide with 3' Sidewalk on west side
- Originally built in 1955 and then widened in 1989
- Bridge Sufficiency Rating is 43 out of 100

## Existing Roadway

- Open Section with 11'+ lane in each direction
- Roadway posted speed limit of 35 mph

## Existing Hydraulics/Drainage






# **Proposed Bridge and Roadway**

- The overall bridge length is 70 foot with a 54-foot wide deck and a 5-foot, 1-inch wide sidewalk on both sides
- The bridge is made up of 17 Prestressed Concrete Box Beams
- The roadway is closed section with a 12-foot lane and a 15-foot shoulder and bike lane on both sides
- The bridge will now be able to pass a 100-year storm




