Commissioner Straughn is non-voting member of Prince George’s County Commission on Common Ownership Communities. She received her law degree at the University of Baltimore Law School, and her undergraduate degree from Towson University. She is an Assistant Attorney General and Director of the Mediation Unit for the Consumer Protection Division, which mediates disputes between consumers and businesses. Under her direction, the mediation unit handles approximately 10,000 complaints each year, and has a 60% success rate. She has held this position for over 10 years. Prior to the Consumer Protection Division, Ms. Straughn served 3 years as the Director of Consumer Complaints, Property & Casualty Unit, for the Maryland Insurance Administration, after working as a private attorney in the insurance defense field. She received her law degree in 1998 at the University of Baltimore Law School, and her undergraduate degree from Towson University.
