



# PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY MOWING AND MAINTENANCE

The Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) is responsible for one of the County's most valuable assets – a public roadway network with more than 2,000 miles. Our overall efforts are aimed at keeping the roads and public right-of-way along County roadways in a state of good repair. The right-of-way is an easement dedicated for placement of water, gas, electric, and other utilities

➤ **Critical Services include:**

- Mowing grass
  - Landscape maintenance such as mulching, trimming and weeding plant beds
  - Roadside litter and illegal sign removal
- DPW&T cares for more than 2,700 acres of grass alongside roadways each growing season
- More than 750 sites are mowed by County crews and contractors every 2-6 weeks between March and November, depending on weather conditions
- Residents are responsible for maintaining their own property alongside the public roadway

The Prince George's County's roadway network includes more than 2,000 miles of public streets.
