Allegedly on April 27, 2018, Mottdricka Jackson's dogs were running at large when they attacked Ms. Scott's dog. Mottdricka Jackson was found in violation of Section 3-185.01 'Pit Bull Terriers' of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

Allegedly on April 27, 2018, Mottdricka Jackson's 6-year old, female, brindle and white, mixed Pit Bull Terrier named 'Reese' and 6-year old, male, blue with white Pit Bull Terrier named 'Blue' were running at large when they attacked Ms. Scott's dog. Your dogs show the propensity to be vicious by virtue of the alleged attack. This is in violation of Section 3-131 'Manner of Keeping Animals', Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance conditions and animals; procedures; appeals', Section 3-135 'Animals at Large Prohibited', Section 3-136 'Vicious Animals', Section 3-145 'Ferret, dog and cat licenses', Section 3-186 'Vaccination of ferrets, dogs and cats' and Section 3-185.01 'Pit Bull Terriers' of the Prince George's County Code.

No. 40-18 ANITA BROOKER

v.

CHARGES:

For return of custody of a male, white, Bichon Frise named 'Casper'. Allegedly Anita Brooker was found in violation of Section 3-180 'Cruelty and Neglect', Section 3-131 'Manner of Keeping Animals', 3-133 'Sanitary conditions', Section

3-186 'Vaccination of ferrets, dogs and cats', and Section 3-145 'Ferret, dog and cat license of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

Allegedly, Lachell Douglas' female, tan and black dog was running at large, barking and defecating on property other than its own. This is in violation of Section 3-131 'Manner of Keeping Animals', Section 3-134 'Excessive noise by an animal prohibited', Section 3-135 'Animals at Large Prohibited', and Section 3-139 'Defecation; Removal of excrement' of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

Allegedly, Henri Gardner is in non-compliance of the Commission for Animal Control's Orders dated October 5, 2018, by virtue of Conclusions and Orders #1-3, which **FINDS** Gardner **GUILTY** of violating Section 3-131 'Manner of Keeping Animals', Section 3-135 'Animals Running at Large Prohibited' and Section 3-145 'Ferret, dog and cat licenses' of the Prince George's County Code. It also **ORDERED** that the dog be muzzled and on a secure leash in control of a responsible adult whenever the dog is outside of his house. This is in violation of Section 3-110 'Hearing Procedures; Findings and Orders' of the Prince George's County Code.

GENERAL RULES

Cases shall be called in the order in which they appear on the docket. The Commission may consider cases out of the order presented on the written docket, at the discretion of the Chairperson, to promote efficiency and as an accommodation to the parties involved.

All attempts will be made to allot time fairly to opposing parties and witnesses. However, all persons testifying under oath shall speak only after receiving recognition and consent of the Chairperson.

Hearings are open to the public. Verbal and physical disruptions from the public are prohibited. Members of the public are required to comply with rules, directives, and orders of the Commission.
