<u>Michael Etienne</u> stated that he is a resident of Silver Spring; that he operates The Rail; that the restaurant is located in College Park; that the transfer has been approved; that they are waiting for the use and occupancy permit to effectuate the license; that the inspection is scheduled for Tuesday; that this is an application for a Special Entertainment Permit; that the security plan was approved by Corporal Cicale; that the University of Maryland Police have approved the security plan. <u>Corporal Cicale</u> stated that she is with the Prince George's County Police Department; that she met with the owners three weeks ago; that the security is adequate; that she has requested transparency and communication with the owners because of the problems with the previous owners. Vladimir Hernandez stated that he does not require an attorney; that they will offer karaoke; that this is family entertainment.

<u>Corporate Cicale</u> stated that she met with the owner two months ago; that food is the main focus of the business; that the security plan is adequate.

Ms. Kelsey moved to approve the Special Entertainment Permit, seconded by Mr. Miles and made unanimous by Mr. Bowman and Mr. Camacho.

In the matter of **t/a Greenbelt Shell Food Mart,** Class A, Beer and Wine, SAHI, Inc., 8711 Greenbelt Road, Greenbelt, 20770, Board requests the licensee presence to discuss the failure to place the license in use.

Shahzad Raja stated that he is a resident of Ellicott City; that this is a Class A, Beer and Wine License; that the business does not sell beer nor wine; that they haven't sold beer and wine for 12 years; that

<u>Mei Chen</u> stated that she is a resident of Greenbelt; that the business is located in a shopping center with a liquor store; that they have not used the license in 2 years; that they are mostly a carryout business; that they have been looking for a new location for the license; that they haven't found a location yet; that they currently have an eight year lease; that they are planning to expand the business; that they have been looking for a new location for 1.5 years; that they could have a location in Forest Heights; that they are looking to open a restaurant with an off sale package store attached; that they thought they could operate as a B+ license.
