## **EXECUTIVE ORDER**

## No. 23-2021 October 29, 2021

WHEREAS, Section 16-219(b) of the Prince George's County Code provides that the County Executive shall establish the dates of observance for the regular holidays for employees of the County by Executive Order;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,** that the dates of observance of holidays for Calendar Year 2022 are hereby established as follows:

| New Year's Day                         | Friday, December 31, 2021*  |

| Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday | Monday, January 17, 2022    |
| Presidents' Day                        | Monday, February 21, 2022   |
| Memorial Day                           | Monday, May 30, 2022        |
| Juneteenth Day                         | Monday, June 20, 2022       |
| Independence Day                       | Monday, July 4, 2022        |
| Labor Day                              | Monday, September 5, 2022   |
| Native American Day                    | Monday, October 10, 2022    |
| Veteran's Day                          | Friday, November 11, 2022   |
| Thanksgiving Day                       | Thursday, November 24, 2022 |
| County Employees' Appreciation Day     | Friday, November 25, 2022   |
| Christmas Day                          | Monday, December 26, 2022   |

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED,** that the dates of observance of holidays as established above shall apply to employees not covered by collective bargaining agreements and to employees covered by collective bargaining agreements where a holiday established by the Personnel Law is also a holiday established in the appropriate collective bargaining agreement and the agreement does not specify the date of observance.

\*New Year's Day is being observed on Friday, December 31, 2021 in accordance with Section 16-219(b) of the Prince George's County Code since New Year's Day falls on a Saturday.
