# 1. Report from Chief Clark:

- a. R.R. No. 39 Hours and Days of Sale for all Class A, Off Sale Licenses
  1) t/a C.D. Liquors
- 2. t/a Esquire Liquors, see letter dated August 27, 2024, regarding a request to transfer the 50% membership interest from stockholder Yogeshkumar M. Patel to current licensee Viraj J. Patel, increasing his membership interest to 100%.
- **3.** t/a Astor Wine & Liquor, see letter dated September 23, 2024, regarding notification of the security interest between the establishment and Colony Bank.
- 4. t/a JCK Bar & Lounge, see email dated September 27, 2024, regarding a request to approve a change in the restaurant's interior design to add extra seating to accommodate the audience when utilizing the entertainment permit.
- **5.** t/a KitchenCray, see email dated October 1, 2024, regarding a request to change the tradename to Zells Kitchen and Lounge.
