In the matter of **t/a Sakura Japanese Steakhouse & Seafood House**, the Board reviewed an alleged Purchases by Authorized Retailer violation. Mr. Camacho moved for an offer and compromise with a fine of \$250 and to take an Alcohol Awareness Training. Approved by unanimous consent.

In the matter of **t/a Crab Café**, see email dated November 4, 2024, regarding a request to close the establishment on December 22, 2024, and December 29, 2024, for church services. Additionally, the establishment would also like to close on December 25-26, 2024, for the Christmas holiday.

The Commissioners voted by unanimous consent to approve the request to close the establishment on December 22, 2024, and December 29, 2024, for church services, as well as on December 25-26, 2024, for the Christmas holiday.

In the matter of **t/a College Park Liquors**, see email dated November 5, 2024, regarding a request to approve an additional one-hundred eighty (180) days to continue to search for a new location to apply for a Transfer of Location, to maintain the active status of the liquor license. The licensees have encountered significant challenges in finding a suitable location in College Park due to certain retail locations not permitting liquor stores in the area. Furthermore, they have faced two unsuccessful attempts to sell the license, as potential buyers were unable to secure a lease for retail space. (*2nd request*)

The Commissioners voted by unanimous consent to approve the request an additional one-hundred eighty days to continue to search for a new location to apply for a Transfer of Location, to maintain the active status of the liquor license.

In the matter of **t/a Fish Market Restaurant**, see letter dated November 7, 2024, regarding a request to close the restaurant until November 30, 2024, due to supply chain issues. (*2nd request*)

The Commissioners voted by unanimous consent to approve the request to close the restaurant until November 30, 2024, due to supply chain issues.

In the matter of **t/a Moxy's Bar & Grill**, see email dated November 10, 2024, regarding a request to approve an additional ninety (90) days to effectuate the license. The establishment is still experiencing delays with DPIE and PGFD Office of the Fire Marshall. (*4th request*)
