



APPLICATION FOR GROCERY STORE TAX CREDIT

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY CODE CB-18-2014

In accordance with the provisions of § Subtitle 10 of the Prince George's County Code, the owner of a grocery store may receive a property tax credit against 75% of the increased county property taxes imposed on the grocery store.

For a grocery store to qualify for the tax credit, it must be located within a Grocery Store Focus Area. A Grocery Store Focus Area is designated as being in a food desert by the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Housing and Economic Development. **The NAICS Code for a food desert area is 445110.**

The application shall be filed no later than **October 1** of the first taxable year for which the credit is sought. All taxes are due and payable when issued.
