CHARGES:

The Prince George’s County Animal Services Division is requesting an Animal Control Commission hearing regarding four horses from this location. All four animals were reported to be in the care of Robert Stanback. These animals were impounded on October 16, 2024, with the approval of a licensed veterinarian. The horses were impounded due to unsafe living conditions, lack of proper food, water, shelter, one horse being malnourished and declining condition of two other horses. This is in violation of Section 3-131 ‘Manner of Keeping Animals’, Section 3-132 ‘Public Nuisance Conditions’; Section 3-133. Sanitary conditions for care and maintenance of animals; Section 3-135 ‘Animals at large prohibited’; Section 3-142 ‘Irresponsible Pet Owner’; Section 3-144. Disposal of an animal carcass; Section 3-165. Riding school and stable license; and Section 3-180 ‘Animal Cruelty and Neglect; prohibited’ of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

The Prince George’s County Animal Services Division is requesting a Dangerous dog hearing for the above listed animal(s). Allegedly on November 26, 2024, Mr. Perry’s dog “Logan” was reported to be running at large and attacked Mr. Payne’s dog “Jacob Jr”. The attack resulted in severe injury to Mr. Payne’s dog which was taken to the emergency vet. While being treated at the vet hospital “Jacob Jr” passed from his injuries. This is in violation of Section 3-131 (c) ‘Manner of Keeping; Prohibition of Nuisances’; Section 3-132 ‘Public Nuisance Conditions’;

Section 3-135 ‘Animals at large prohibited’; Section 3-136 ‘Dangerous Animals’; Section 3-142 ‘Irresponsible Pet Owner’; Section 3-145 ‘Ferret, dog, and cat licenses’; Section 3-182 ‘Potentially Dangerous Animals’; and Section 3-186 ‘Vaccination of dogs, cats, and ferrets’.

CHARGES:

The Prince George’s County Animal Services Division is requesting an Animal Control Commission hearing regarding the above listed animal(s) impounded from the address. “Gimbo” was found improperly tethered, jumped the fence into the neighboring property, and was strangling himself. The second dog “Mikey” was found with improper shelter in inclement weather. The dogs were impounded for their health and safety after previously advising the owner of the necessary corrections to maintain their dog per the county code that were not made. This is in violation of Section 3-131(a) (3) ‘Manner of Keeping Animals – Proper Shelter’; Section 3-131(a) (6) ‘Manner of Keeping Animals- Proper Care’; Section 3-131(a) (12) ‘Manner of Keeping Animals- Proper Cleaning’; Section 3-133 ‘Sanitary conditions for care and maintenance of animals; Section 3-142 ‘Irresponsible Pet Owner’; Section 3-145 ‘Ferret, dog, and cat licenses’ ; Section 3-180 ‘Animal Cruelty and Neglect; prohibited’ ; Section 3-181 ‘Unlawful restraint of dogs’; 3-186 ‘Vaccination of Dogs, Cats, and Ferrets for Rabies ‘of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

The Prince George’s Animal Services Division is requesting a non-compliance hearing for the above referenced property/animal owner, Jamie Powell. Mr. Powell was brought before the Commission for Animal Control on September 25, 2024, for a vicious Dog Hearing in reference to his dogs running at large and

attacking the next-door neighbor's dog at 4702 Brinkley Road. Mr. Powell has failed to comply with the vicious dog restrictions most recently November 19, 2024, where his dog "Chill" a terrier mix was running at large and entered into the yard of 4700 Brinkley Road and attacking their German Shepherd in it's own fenced backyard. The injuries led to the amputation of the shepherd's rear leg. "Chill" is currently in custody at the Animal Services facility. This is in violation of the Commission for Animal Control Case No. 119-24 VA. Section 3-131 'Manner of Keeping Animals'; Section 3-135 'Animals at large prohibited'; Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner'; and Section 3-186 'Vaccination of dogs, cats, and ferrets.' of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

Allegedly on February 4, 2025, Mr. Manjano's dogs "Sky" and "Duke" were reported to be running at large and attacked Ms. Castro's chickens that were confined in a coop in her backyard. The attack on Ms. Castro's chickens resulted in the death of the entire flock. This is in violation of Section 3-131 (c) 'Manner of Keeping; Prohibition of Nuisances'; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-135 'Animals at Large Prohibited'; Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner'; Section 3-145 'Ferret, dog, and cat licenses'; Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animals'; and Section 3-186 'Vaccination of ferrets, dogs, and cats'.
