CHARGES:

Allegedly, Mr. Johnson has a large, tan, Pitbull that has been a public nuisance by being constantly loose and trespassing into Mr. Ntewo's property. Mr. Ntewo stated that the dogs look food deprived and they are worried for their family's safety. This is in violation of Section 3-131(c) 'Manner of Keeping Animals', Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-135 'Animals at large prohibited'; Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner', Section 3-180. Animal Cruelty and Neglect; prohibited; Section 3-185.01. 'Pit Bull Terriers'; Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animals'; and Section 3-186 'Vaccination of dogs, cats, and ferrets.' of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

This is in violation of Section 3-131 (c) 'Manner of Keeping; Prohibition of Nuisances'; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance

Conditions'; Section 3-135 'Animal at large prohibited'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner'; Section 3-145 'Ferret, dog, and cat license'; Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animals'; and Section 3-186 'Vaccination of dogs, cats, and ferrets'; of the Prince George's County Code.
