Enhanced Preferences for Diverse Suppliers – Effective February 3, 2025, Council Bill CB-060-2024, which amends provisions of Subtitle 10A – 108 -Exemptions of the County Code takes effect. Procurements that are subject to exemptions found in Section 10A-108(a) should now consider preference for County-based and County-located businesses.

The proposed legislation aims to create a level playing field for all businesses, fostering trust, transparency, and positive relationships within the business community, while promoting economic growth and innovation for those entrepreneurs based in Prince George's County.
