ORDER


Pursuant to the authority conferred on this Commission by Prince George's County Code, Subtitle 2, Division 12, Subdivision 1, §2-185 et seq. (2023 Edition) and MD Code, State Government, § 10-210 (formerly, Article 41 of the Administrative Procedures Act of the State of Maryland), and for the reasons set forth in the Memorandum Opinion, the Commission issues the following Order:

Upon consideration of: (1) Respondent's Motion to Dismiss, or in the Alternative, For Summary Judgment submitted by and through counsel for Respondent; (2) Complainant's Response to Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative, For Summary Judgment submitted by and through counsel for the Executive Director; (3) the parties' arguments presented at the Pre-hearing conference held on May 9, 2024; (4) Respondent's Post-Hearing Conference Brief received on May 10, 2024; and (5) the parties' exhibits, it is on this 20th day of May 2024, hereby,

ORDERED, that the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss is **DENIED**, but Respondent's Motion for Summary Judgment is **GRANTED**; and it is further,

ORDERED, that the Complaint initiating this action, OHR23-0605, is dismissed with prejudice.

Under Section 2-197-C of the Prince George's County Code, any party aggrieved by a final decision of the Commission in a contested case is entitled to file an appeal pursuant to Chapter 200, Title 7 of the Maryland Rules of Procedure, Annotated Code of Maryland, within thirty (30) days from the date last entered above.
