

## LIST OF THE ELIGIBLE PERMIT TYPES

## **Permit Availability**

Window Well — New/Replacement

The Virtual Walk-Through Permit Process\* is available for Residential Homeowner case types only. (This does NOT include Use & Occupancy case types or properties serviced by a private well and/or septic system.) Virtual Permit Center walk-through customers can include more than one scope of work in their permit application as indicated in the chart below.

	Combining VPC Scope of Work	Combine with Items
•	Accessory Structures (Gazebo, Garage, Pergola, Shed, Carport Only) — No more than 500 sq. ft. and 15 ft. high; alteration and repair of existing accessory structure; no change in use.	<ul> <li>If new garage, no other items.</li> <li>If new carport, max 2 items, except "Addition"</li> <li>Rest, additional items ok.</li> </ul>
•	<b>Addition to Single Family Dwelling</b> — No more than 500 sq. ft. and no more than one story high at ground level; no party walls. No interior or exterior renovation of existing house. View the "Minimum Plan Submission Requirements for Additions."	No other items allowed with this scope.
•	Areaway — New/Replacement	Max 3 additional items
•	Awning — 24" deep	Max 3 additional items
•	Basement Finishing	Max 3 additional items
•	Damage Report — If drawings are NOT required	Max 3 additional items
•	<b>Deck, One Level</b> — No more than 1000 sq. ft.	Max 3 additional items
•	Drywall — New/Replacement	Max 3 additional items
•	Fence — New/Replacement	Max 3 additional items
•	Fire Pit	Max 3 additional items
•	Fireplace Inserts	Max 3 additional items
•	Interior Non-Load-Bearing Wall Demolition	Max 3 additional items
•	<b>Interior Remodeling/Alteration and Repair</b> — One level; no structural work. (Examples: no additions, alteration or repairs to foundation, beams, intellijacks, posts, columns, load-bearing walls.)	Max 1 additional item
•	Patio — More than 500 sq. ft. requires a permit	Max 3 additional items
•	Pergola/Trellis	Max 3 additional items
•	Porch and Steps — New/Repair; no more than 500 sq. ft.	Max 1 additional item
•	Portico	Max 3 additional items
•	Ramp — New/Replacement	Max 3 additional items
•	<b>Retaining Wall</b> — New/Replacement; less than 5 ft. measured from top of footing	Max 3 additional items
•	<b>Roof Sheathing Replacement</b> — No permit required for replacing SHINGLES ONLY	Max 3 additional items
•	<b>Shed</b> — Over 150 sq. ft. or more than one shed on a property requires a permit	Max 3 additional items
•	Tanks, Above Ground & Underground — Removal/Installation	Max 3 additional items
•	Walkway/Stoop — New/Replacement	Max 3 additional items
•	Waterproofing — Exterior/Interior	Max 3 additional items
•	Window/Door Replacement/Repair — No permit required if in-kind (same size)	Max 3 additional items

<sup>\*</sup> Applicants must complete the walk-through process and receive issuance of one application in order to check-in with a new application number.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Above scope is only for VPC homeowners, MHIC contractors and homeowner representatives to apply for existing residential (one- and two-family dwellings and townhouses not more than 3 stories) projects.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> DPIE staff reserves the right to change an application from virtual walk-through review to file for regular ePlan review.

## VIRTUAL WALK-THROUGH PERMIT PROCESS INSTRUCTIONS

- Access Momentum, DPIE's permitting platform, to start your application.
- Complete and submit your online application and check the "Virtual Walk-Through" option.
- You will be required to upload your plans.
- During the virtual session, you will receive email and text messages with updates of the plan review process.
- **IMPORTANT**: You need to monitor these notifications as you will be required to join a video/audio session with plan reviewers.
- At the end of the review, you will receive a notification to pay for your permit.
   Your permit will then be available in the Approved-Permit Set folder for you to download and print.

DPIE is currently offering virtual review for **HOMEOWNER PERMITS ONLY** (see the list of eligible permit types on page 1 of this document). We plan to expand the walk-through process in the future.
