

Preconstruction: Primary Objective

 Service repeat clients and Win Work on a negotiated basis.

How?

- Phasing alternatives and schedule compression
- Cost Savings solutions and Alternative design
- Cost estimating at Conceptual, Schematic, and Design Development document stages
- Constructability reviews

Estimating

 The scope review, processing, and assembly of Subcontractor quotations during the Bid Phase to provide Owners with the highest quality proposals possible.

Estimating: Primary Objectives

 Craft a detailed response tailored to RFP requirements and Win Work on a competitive basis.

How?

- Comprehensive proposals
- Cost Savings Solutions
- Innovative Constructability approaches

Estimating and Preconstruction

What can Subcontractors do?

- Consistently Respond to Bid Invitations
- Submit Proposals that meet the Scope as Outlined
- Offer Trade Specific Input
- Post your Best Number on Bid Day
- Post Bids on Time (or Early!)

Purchasing

 The award of Subcontracts to capable professionals to perform the work on a Project. This includes parts and pieces, skilled labor, and expertise.

Purchasing: Primary Objectives

 Review project requirements, evaluate Subcontractors, and Award Work.

How?

- Analyze Subcontractor Capability
- Review Subcontractor Availability
- Confirm Terms and Scope
- Evaluate Price to Include Factors Above

Analyze subcontractor capability

- Prequalification Form
- Past performance (Within and Outside FCC)
- Financial stability and Bondability
- Safety Record

Review subcontractor availability

- Does Sub have sufficient manpower?
- Can Sub meet lead times for materials?

Confirm Terms and Scope

- Confirm Sub has agreed to our terms
 - Forrester uses a boilerplate
 Master Subcontract Agreement(MSA)
- Review FCC Scope of Work with Sub

Evaluate Price (to Include Factors Above)

 Compare final pricing from the subs who passed the first 3 tests.

Based on all information gathered:

Select the optimal Subcontractor for that work.

Follow Up
