Presentation is Everything ~ Verbal and Non-verbal

- •What do you want your attire to say about you!
- •Always wear neat attire, keep extra attire with you.
- •Know the dress code.
- •A suit is never out of style.
- •Keep your nails clean.
- •Wear clothes which you are comfortable in & can carry well.
- •Women should avoid wearing exposing dresses, opt for little but natural make-ups based on your industry.
- Men need to keep their hair neatly trimmed

- •Extend your hand, two-three pumps
- •Smile while speaking
- •Say your first name, then full name
- •Stand when speaking
- •Introduce the person with the highest authority
- •Ask to provide your business card
- •Present your business card facing the person
- •ALWAYS KEEP BUSINESS CARDS WITHYOU, never leave home without them.





- •Answer with a smile
- Provide a clear and concise voice mail
- •Ask do have a few minutes to talk
- •Ask permission before placing a person on hold
- •Let the caller hang up first
- •Return calls within a 48-hours
- •Keep your cell phone on vibrate
- •Keep your call private, the office/elevator does not want to hear it





➡What to Say & How to Say It

- •Start with greeting Hello, Good Morning, etc.
- •Respond in 48-hours
- •Always include a signature line
- •Provide an auto-respond message
- •Always maintain highest level of formality
- •Do not reply all if the message is intended to the sender

- •Send thank you note within 48-hours
- •Never point with your finger, use your palm
- •Maintain eye contact when speaking
- •Be mindful how you use your hands when speaking
- •Refrain from crossing your legs





- •Use social media to build your brand
- •Provide information that people will need
- •Always remember, what you post, people will see and remember





- •BBE Break, Butter and Eat
- •Never ask for a Go Box
- •Respectfully decline alcohol (subject to event/discussion)
- •When ordering, follow the host selection
- Host should pay
- •Know & understand the placement of table setting
- •Be prepared for conversation (keep politics, religion at home)
